Important Editorial Announcements

Thanks to the contributions of fellow researchers, **Electronic Journal of General Medicine** (formerly known as **European Journal of General Medicine**) is celebrating its 14th year in publication. The journal is now included in major indexes and databases such as ESCI and SCOPUS. We are a dynamic community that renews itself to the needs and standards of the modern era. Hence, on behalf of the Editorial Team, we are pleased to make important announcements.

- Title of "European Journal of General Medicine" is changed to "Electronic Journal of General Medicine" (abbreviated as Electron J Gen Med; ISSN 2516-3507). Starting with volume 15 issue 2, the journal will be released under the new title Electronic Journal of General Medicine.
- 2) **Electronic Journal of General Medicine** was published in print and online before. Starting with volume 15 issue 2, the journal will be published online only.
- 3) Publication frequency of **Electronic Journal of General Medicine** is changed from quarterly to bimonthly. Starting with volume 15 issue 2, the journal will be published as 1 volume per year with 6 issues.
- 4) Starting with volume 15 issue 2, article numbers will be used to identify individual articles instead of page numbers.
- 5) Similarity Check will be used to prevent academic dishonesty.
- 6) **Electronic Journal of General Medicine** is pleased to announce new award program for best paper (including a certificate and an honorarium of 10,000 USD) and best reviwer (including a certificate and an honorarium of 2,000 USD).

Note that above changes **do not** affect the indexing status of the journal. **Electronic Journal of General Medicine** will continue to be indexed by ESCI and SCOPUS. As a peer-reviewed medical journal publishing original articles in the fields of general medicine, **Electronic Journal of General Medicine** continues its dedication to serve as an international forum of high quality research material.
